

## AMA Announces Webinar on PI CME in Medical School Settings

This webinar is scheduled for Wednesday, June 4 at 1:00pm CDT. Designed for CME providers in medical schools, this session will discuss the whys and hows of PI CME - a critical tool in helping physicians improve patient care.

### OBJECTIVES:

At the end of this 90-minute presentation, the participant will be able to:

- Describe components of a PI CME activity that meet the requirements for *AMA PRA Category 1 Credit™*
- Identify sources of evidence-based performance measures that can be used as the basis for a PI CME activity
- Recognize the value of PI CME activities for both physicians and CME stakeholders – today and in the future
- Describe how at least one medical school has implemented a PI CME activity
- Discuss how to encourage and facilitate physician participation in CME

This webinar will also include a Q/A period with the presenters.
